- 1835 September 25, Deed Book F, pp. 170-171. Warranty Deed. **John Pierce** and **Clary** (his wife) of Shelby Co., IN, sold 40a to **John Nail** of same for \$100.00. Description: S half of the E half of the SW quarter, Sec 25, Twp 13N, R 6E. Signed **John Pierce** and **Clary Pierce** (both by mark). Witnesses: Charles Trach (?) and Anderson Keith. Dated 25 September 1835. Recorded 30 March 1836. (Deed)
- 1839 May 27, Deed Book H, p. 779. Warranty Deed. Hermon Avery sold 107/100a to **Colvin Pierce** for \$5.00. Description: part of the E half of the NE quarter, Sec 9, Twp 11, R 8. Signed Hermon Avery. No Witness. Dated 27 May 1839. Recorded 02 July 1839. (Deed Index)
- 1842 August 15, Deed Book J, p. 589. Warranty Deed. James Jacobus and Eliza Jacobus (his wife) of Decatur Co., IN, sold 83.75a to **Colvin Pierce**, guardian for Aaron M. Broadrich, Alvia P. Broadrich, and Hannah H. Broadrich, minor heirs of Solomon Brodersck, decd of Shelby Co., IN, for \$310.00. Description: E half of the NE quarter, Sec 4, Twp 11, R 8. Signed James Jacobus and Eliza Jacobus. Witnesses: John Devall and Maria Devall. Dated 15 August 1842. Recorded 25 August 1842. (Deed Index)
- 1843 May 12, Deed Book K, pp. 448-449. Warranty Deed. William H. Langsdale of Marion Co., IN, sold lot 14 in Pleasant View to **John Pierce** of Marion Co., IN, for \$100.00. Signed William H. Langsdale and Catharine Langsdale. Witnesses: R. C. Allison and Joseph A. Levy. Dated 12 May 1843. Recorded 13 September 1844. (Deed Index)
- 1844 July 30, Deed Book M, p. 76. Warranty Deed. **James Wray** and **Tabitha** (his wife) and **Wiley Wray** and **Hannah** (his wife) of Shelby Co., IN, sold 80a to **Sion Pierce** of same for \$326.00. Description: W half of the SE quarter, Sec 15, Twp 13, R 6E. Signed **James Wray**, **Tabitha Wray** (by mark), **Wiley Wray**, and **Hannah Wray** (by mark). Witnesses: John L. Campbell, Margaret Finley, and Aaron R. Neoward (?Howard). Dated 30 July 1844. Recorded 18 June 1846. (Deed)
- 1848 January 24, Deed Book O, p. 442. Warranty Deed. George W. Delap and Fanny W. Delap (his wife) of Shelby Co., IN, sold 40a to **Sion Peirce** of same for \$350.00. Description: S half of the W half of the SW quarter, Sec 14, Twp 13, R 6E. Signed George W. Delap and Fanny W. Delap. Witness: Jeremiah Odell. Dated 24 July 1848. Recorded 01 January 1849. (Deed)
- 1848 January 24, Deed Book O, p. 518. Warranty Deed. **Sion Pierce** and **Sarah E. Pierce** (his wife) of Shelby Co., IN, sold 80a to Jeremiah Odell of same for \$467.00. Description: W half of the SE quarter, Sec 15, Twp 13, R 6E. Signed **Sion Pierce** and **Sary E. Pierce**. Witness: Henry Jenkins. Dated 24 July 1848. Recorded 30 January 1849. (Deed)

1850 April 13, Deed Book Q, p. 394. Quit Claim. David Thacher (also Thatcher) and Amelia A. Thatcher of Shelby Co., IN, granted their interest in a tract of land to **Sion Pierce** for \$20.00. Description: SW quarter of the SW quarter, Sec 14, Twp 13, R 6E. Signed David Thacher and Amelia A. Thacher. No witnesses. Dated 13 April 1850. Recorded 01 May 1850. (Deed)

1850 May 04, Deed Book Q, p. 395. Warranty Deed. **Sion Pierce** and **Sarah E. Pierce** (his wife) of Shelby Co., IN, sold 40a to John N. Snider of Hamilton Co., OH, for \$400.00. Description: S half of the W half of the SW quarter, Sec 14, Twp 13, R 6. Signed **Sion Pierce** and **Sarah E. Pierce** (by mark). Witnesses: James Norvell and Jacob Kinney. Dated 04 May 1850. Recorded 06 May 1850. (Deed)
